Report

On a sunny Sunday 9th April we launched our tournament season with the annual Bath Spring Albion competition. This was the first time I had ever organised an archery tournament, so I was anticipating some massive, unexpected mishap, some oversight on my part, that would completely ruin the event. But it didn't happen. I think we all had a really enjoyable day, and there was some great shooting. I have been told that the nice thing about the Bath Albion is that, though it's a tournament, it's a pretty relaxed, informal affair, meaning archers feel comfortable and can rack up some great scores. And I think that certainly happened this time round.

We had a total of 41 archers from across the region on the shooting line, with two, sadly, unable to make it through injury. There were 12 women and 29 men on the line - 17 Longbow shooters, 14 Recurvers, 9 Compound archers, and one lonely Barebowman.

The Field Captain for the day was Bath Archers' very own Steve Hammond, and a sterling job he did. His commanding presence and his occasional merry tormenting of individual archers kept the tournament bubbling throughout. Shooting started at 10.30am after a rambling intro from me and a bit more clarity from Steve. The day went very smoothly, and quite quickly, with, as I remember at one stage, Steve estimating that arrows were being shot at a rate of 20 minutes per dozen.

Our Lady Paramount for the day was Stella Simmons, President of Bath Archers and a long-time member of the club, clocking up 50 years this year. I'd like to thank Stella for agreeing to hand out the trophies and prizes on what wasn't the warmest day, and for regaling me with stories of her impressive archery exploits when she was younger.

We made £118.00 in the raffle. There were lots of great prizes. My thanks to all who donated stuff, and all of you who bought tickets. It was interesting how the draw seemed to defy the laws of probability, given the number of prizes won by the group of chaps to my right! Proceeds this year will go to club funds.

I would like to thank the Bath Archers team who gave their time on the Friday morning before the shoot, and early on Sunday morning, to get everything ready. Stu Ohren deserves particular mention for master-minding the setting-up of what looked like a fantastic field, and Duncan Garner who spent a lot of time mowing important bits of the field because we had been unable to get the grass cut due to the flood. I'd also like to thank the people who worked behind the scenes during the day with the catering and the results collation and I must give special thanks to Kathy and Steve Hammond for all the support they gave me with the organisation of the event.

Finally, a big thank you, to you, the competitors, for coming to our Bath Albion and making it such a great day. We will hopefully see you next year.
