Hereford TO

A Hereford round you are shooting today

In one detail, six shafts at a time.

I'll be timing four minutes per end by the way

Using whistles to keep you in line

When you stand on the line and the weather is fine

And your recurve you aim at the spider

If some arrows score ten, you should call me then

I'll check them all with my divider

Your mobiles should all be switched off or on silent

Or better still left in your tent

We don't want to make other archers feel violent

But distracting them when bows are bent

With compound you hope what you see through the scope

Is the point that your arrow will land

If it's nearest the cross in the midst of the boss

Then you'll leave with a prize in your hand

If you have a bouncer or your kit throws a fault

To the judge make your problem quite plain

If awake, he'll come over and at the next halt

Let you shoot any shafts which remain

If your shafts you let fly pointing up to the sky

Then it's longbow you're shooting today

But if you get it right then your arrow in flight

Might just land in the gold anyway

Please fill in your score sheets in blue or black pen

Cos a red pen is just for officials

If an error is made, call me over and then

I'll adjust it and add my initials

If a barebow you held with your pile on the gold

And you fingers set firmly in place

If you aim's not awry then your arrow will fly

To a prize-winning spot on the face

Put a shaft in the gold and the judge should be told
He will check them and then choose the best
Of the shafts in the middle and without any quibble
Choose a winner, rejecting the rest.
